

Math Expectations 2022 Summer Entering 8th Grade

Dear Incoming 8th Grade Parents,

In an effort to keep math skills at a high level, Saint Theresa Catholic School math teachers require students to keep practicing those skills over the summer.

To make this easier on parents several options are possible.

- 1. You may order a Spectrum math book from Amazon (requirements below),**
- 2. Attend summer school (Brophy), attend a program like Kumon or Mathnasium, or**
- 3. Individual tutoring.**

During the first week of school in August, students should bring in documentation of their work. This might be the completed Spectrum book, a note from the tutor including the number of hours and dates met, topics covered and work completed, or an official report card or progress report from a summer program.

Registration for Brophy summer school begins soon. Please go to their website and look at the summer enrichment classes: <https://www.brophyprep.org/academics/summer-school> The class we recommend is **MATH PRE-8th GRADE.**

We expect 15-20 hours of total work. Students who choose to attend summer school at Brophy are expected to miss no more than 1 day to get full credit.
